Our Fall Celebration will be held on ***Monday, October 31***. All students should come to school dressed in costume. If there are accessories like capes, wands, masks etc. those should be sent on that day in a large bag clearly marked with your child's name. Remember to follow the dress code when choosing your child's costume. Things to avoid: plastic weapons, skulls, fake blood, costumes depicting violence, exposed skin, face painting (make-up) etc. This year, have your children avoid clown costumes, as some students associate this costume with the negative aspects of recent events in our area.

The party will begin at 12:45. **Please remember that only the designated homeroom parents will be in the classrooms helping with the party.** Additionally, all students will receive the same snacks and treat bag so please do not send additional food, candy, or treat bags.

The parade will begin at 2:15. Parents should be in place on the parade route no later than 2:00 so there is no unnecessary traffic. The parade route includes Junior Avenue, Fairfield St., Mansfield St., and Fenwick Avenue. You may line up on any of those streets. After the parade you may accompany your child back into the classroom where you may sign him/her out to leave for the day. Any student taking the bus will remain in the classroom.
