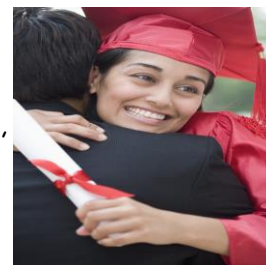


# ACT/SAT PREPARATION COURSE 2020-2021

## REGISTRATION, COST, and PAYMENT OPTIONS



**Students must pre-register for the class.** The cost of the course for Basic/Advanced Math and English is \$210. Interested students need to fill out the accompanying online registration form at <https://bit.ly/ACTPREP2020> and pay the course fee via <https://monongalia.schoolcashonline.com/>. Students may repeat the course at no additional cost; however, all students must complete a registration form showing their intent to take the class so that the instructors have materials prepared for them. If it is possible, this course will be offered in the physical classroom with a virtual option for students who are not at school on a day the class is taught and/or do not feel safe coming into the school building. If for any reason Monongalia County Schools requires this class to only be offered virtually, then the course will move fully to a virtual platform. Any student who is taking the course virtually will receive information on how to enter the class and will join the group via his/her school e-mail address.
