Greetings from the CLES Counseling Department!

My name is Ms. Kaitlin Fetty, and I am the current school counselor for PreK through 2nd grade. Since the age of 5, I have walked through the same doors your children walk through every day spending the first 8 years of my schooling at this building, which were grades K-8 when I was growing up. After graduating from University High School, I attended West Virginia University and received a Bachelor's degree in Psychology and a Master's degree in Counseling. Through my internship, I realized I had such a passion for working with children to help shape healthy lifestyles and positive coping skills to utilize as adults. This is now the start of my sixth year at Cheat Lake Elementary as a school counselor.

The school counseling department at Cheat Lake includes developmental guidance, individual counseling, and group counseling, along with other services. Developmental guidance lessons are given to all students in grades K-2 once or twice a month. Classroom guidance lessons, along with individual counseling and group counseling, focus on areas such as personal space, setting and respecting boundaries (with words and bodies), perseverance, acceptance of differences, peer pressure, mean vs. nice teasing, bullying and mean moments, acts of kindness, blurting, and empathy. School counseling provides all students in the building the opportunity to utilize a professional school counselor to help with social-emotional growth, academic needs, and career development. The professional school counselor uses creative techniques driven by theory to help students become more emotionally and socially well-rounded by practicing healthy lifestyles and implementing positive coping skills.

Currently, I am a provisionally licensed counselor as I complete 2,400 hours of service to children and families along with supervision under Esther Ervin, LPC, ALPS, at WM Counseling to obtain my professional counseling license. LPC stands for Licensed Professional Counselor. I will be having supervision weekly for approximately the next 15 months. Supervision is a process that provides high quality consultation between a licensed professional counselor and a provisional licensed counselor to enhance skills and deepen knowledge. As part of my supervision, I have provided an online copy of my informed consent. I will also have some quantities available in the lower office at school.
