Superintendent of Schools Eddie Campbell here with an update about Monongalia County Schools' re-entry plans for this coming week.

Earlier this evening, the State Department of Education designated Mon County as a "green" level COVID-19 county for September 28th through October second.

Although we're all excited to see kids in our classrooms as soon as possible, we will continue our current remote learning instructional model through this Wednesday, September 30th.

On Thursday and Friday of the coming week, October first and second, we'll initiate the blended learning and distance learning instructional models we've been preparing for the past few months.

Monongalia County Schools is a large and incredibly complex organization with many moving parts.

As we continue to teach our students remotely this coming Monday through Wednesday, we'll also be reactivating direct student services such as transportation and nutrition to meet our students' needs.

You'll receive calls from your children's principals over the next few days detailing their school's specific return-to-learn plans.
