Parks & Recreational Management

- This CTE Program will teach students about hospitality and tourism management and focus on the tourism opportunities in the great state of WV. Students will explore employability and career development in addition to the impact of tourism in WV. Students will utilize problem-solving techniques and participate in hands-on activities/site visits to develop an understanding of the course concepts.

Students will utilize problem-solving techniques and participate in hands-on activities to develop an understanding of the course concepts.
