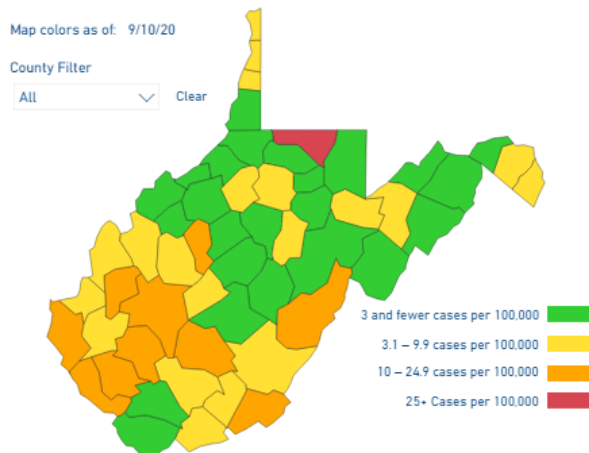


# The Week Ahead
