Welcome to the overall learning guide to Morgantown High School. A new Edition will be updated weekly to alert our students and families on what to expect for the upcoming week at MHS.

Monongalia County has been designated as a county who can deliver In-Person Instruction by the [WVDHHR color coded metric](#) as of Saturday, October 11th.

Impact on Morgantown High School

- In-Person Instruction with MCS Distance Remote learning simultaneously will occur Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday this week. Please see the updated bell schedule later on in this bulletin.
- Wednesday, October 14th the only students that will be on campus are students who are taking the SAT School Day or PSAT-NMSQT. All other students will be completing online assignments. There will be no live conferences on Wednesday.
- Fridays will continue to be remote learning for all students. MHS will be running a full eight period class schedule.
- Sporting events and extracurricular activities will continue at Morgantown High School.
- Any full time MCS Distance students or students who are in remote learning can continue to request lunch from the school by using the following link ([Click here](#)). Students in the building can bring their own lunch or one will be provided to them.

Monday 10/12/2020, Tuesday 10/13/2020, Thursday 10/15/2020 Guidance

- In-Person instruction continues for Hybrid students at Morgantown High School
- MHS will move to the new In-Person class schedule (to the right) to accommodate for additional minutes per class.
- Students who eat breakfast will report directly to the cafeteria while all other students will report directly to their homerooms. All students must be in the building no later than 7:15.
- Monday, October 12th: Morgantown High School will be welcoming students with last names that start with A – L for an EVEN class day. *Students with the last names that start with M – Z will attend their classes remotely on their Chromebooks.*
- Tuesday, October 13th: Morgantown High School will be hosting students with last names that start with M – Z for an EVEN class day. *Students with the last names that start with A - L will attend their classes remotely on their Chromebooks.*
- Thursday, October 15th: Morgantown High School will be hosting students with last names that start with M – Z for an ODD class day. *Students with the last names that start with A - L will attend their classes remotely on their Chromebooks.*
- MCS Distance and Remote learning students will login using their Chromebooks for instructions on teacher expectations at the beginning of each class.

Wednesday 10/14/2020 Guidance

- Monongalia County Schools will be offering the free SAT School Day to our 12th grade students who signed up to take the exam. This is the makeup assessment date for our Spring 2020 testing administration that was cancelled due to Covid.
- Morgantown High School will also be offering the PSAT-NMSQT exam this day to any 10th or 11th grade student who signed up to take the exam.
- All students who are NOT taking the exam should login to Schoology to find their assignments and work at their own pace during the day.
- There will be no live meetings or instruction during the school day.
- The only students who will be at MHS are students who are taking the either exam or students who we have communicated with already.
- Students and parents who are taking the exam are asked to check the email they used to register for the exam for additional details on the testing procedures and room locations.

Friday 10/16/2020 Guidance

- MHS will offer remote instruction for all students on Fridays for the month of October.
- All Students (MCS Distance and In-Person/Hybrid) will follow the Remote Learning All Period class schedule (to the right).
- Classes are shortened to accommodate time for students to meet with instructors to get additional help and answer questions. All students (MCS Distance and Hybrid) will login to each period.
- WVDE Virtual Students will continue with their learning.

Continued Expectations for Students In-Person/Hybrid Learning

- Our campus opens for students at 7:05 am. Please plan accordingly and do not be on campus earlier than that time. All students should be in their homerooms or the cafeteria eating breakfast no later than 7:15 am.
- All students will be required to wear face coverings at all times (School Bus, Class Transitions, In-Class Instruction, etc.). Students will be able to remove face coverings when eating in designated zones during breakfast and lunch times.
- All students must bring their fully charged Chromebook to school with them each day.
